



'Deal or No Deal' gets a new deal from CNBC with game-show revival

Here's the deal: It's time to get briefcases ready again for a certain game show.

"America's Got Talent's" Howie Mandel returns to host a revival of "Deal or No Deal" that starts Wednesday, Dec. 5, on CNBC (following a preview two nights earlier on the parent NBC network, the series' former home). Players again decide whether to keep a selected briefcase, not knowing if it contains one cent or \$1 million, or trade it for what's offered by the person known as "The Banker.

Also an executive producer of "Deal or No Deal," Mandel has taped the new episodes at the Universal Orlando (Fla.) Resort. He reflects that when he was first approached about the program in 2005, "There were no comics hosting game shows, and I said 'No' to it three times. My wife told me to take the deal, and I took the deal.

"I'm not saying it because I'm trying to promote it," Mandel notes, "but this is real: There is no show I've ever been part of — or no project I've ever been part of that has changed my life, that has changed my career, that is more exciting to be part of than 'Deal or No Deal.' For

nine years, I've been trying to scratch and claw my way back onto this stage, and I can't thank CNBC enough for allowing me and our team this opportunity.

CNBC executive Jim Ackerman believes "Deal or No Deal" suits the network's business brand while also possibly expanding it. "In many ways, we feel like we're the perfect destination for 'Deal," he reasons. "There is the life-changing money at stake, the high-pressure balancing act between risk and reward. And at the heart of each game, there is story of someone looking for a shot at a better life. We are super-excited about this, but to do it, we needed to bring back the man at the center of the show. And we did."

That man, Mandel, cites what the appeal of "Deal of No Deal" remains for him, "I don't know if it's because of my age," he says, "but this show made me comfortable with just ... sharing the foibles and the weaknesses and the strengths of being human."

Several of the original "Deal or No Deal" models also are returning, but Season 2 featured a now-notable "Holder of Case No. 24": Meghan Markle, presently the Duchess of Sussex. "She was a very nice person," recalls executive producer Scott St. John. "I can't say that I saw anything extra-special. I mean, all the women that we have on the show are special." However, Mandel adds with tongue in cheek, "She was slightly duchessy."



Rose has said, "I've lived in Bayonne for 100 years and I have no regrets. Bayonne is a wonderful city." Rose is one of the people who has made Bayonne great. Next year, we will be celebrating the 150th anniversary of the City of Bayonne. It is astounding that she has been with us for two-thirds of that history. 

Say "Kentucky" to most people and you'll likely conjure mental images of horse races and bottles of fine whiskey.

And both come into play as Bravo's "Top Chef" heads to the Bluegrass State for its 16th season, which gets underway Thursday Dec. 6, as 15



chefs from across the country compete for the title amid the unique culinary scenes of Louisville, Lexington and Lake Cumberland before heading to Macao, China, for the final showdown.

Along the way, judges Tom Colicchio, Graham Elliot, Nilou Motamed and Gail Simmons and host Padma Lakshmi got to take in the 2018 Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs, watch the contestants cook for Laila Ali at the Muhammad Ali Center, oversee a buzzer beater showdown at Rupp Arena with University of Kentucky basketball coach Jon Calipari and visit the Maker's Mark bourbon distillery.

"Kentucky was fun, actually," Colicchio, the head judge, reports. "I hadn't spent much time there, so it was good to see that part of the country. You know, we were there for the Derby, which was a lot of fun. It was something I always wanted to do and never had an opportunity to get to, so that was a lot of fun. ... Some of the local foods and stuff really came into play nicely. Obviously, bourbon does and so it was a good couple of weeks I spent there."

In fact, one of the highlights of the May-June Iming for Colicchio was overseeing a competition at the Maker's Mark distillery in the tiny town

"It's really an amazing operation ...," Colicchio says. "They're producing a lot of bourbon but really high-quality bourbon ... it's quite an operation. And we did shoot there. We had just a great day there. It was, from what I recall, a beautiful sunny day and we were kind of in between the distillery and a few rickhouses and the setting was really great. That was fun."

And, of course, there was the Kentucky cuisine, of which the contestants were tasked with coming up with their own interpretations. One was a very popular dish known

as burgoo, which is a spicy stew made from game meat.

"For the most part, we were using local ingredients," Colicchio explains. "We used some local beef that was really good. There's things like local soy sauce that's being produced that's really, really good. So we did use some local products as well.

"But I think what happens with the chefs is that they know they're going to Kentucky, they start studying, they started doing some homework, and then I think they also leaned heavily on a contestant that was from Kentucky just to sort of understand the culture a little better."
