The high-tech mystery 'Devs' helps launch FX on Hulu

When it comes to creating other worlds within our world, Alex Garland has proven himself a master.

The filmmaker has done that with his challenging and well-received movies "Ex Machina" and "Annihilation," and

now, he's doing it on television ... or more accurately a streaming service, since his "Devs" becomes the first FX-furnished series to originate on FX on Hulu by debuting the first two of its eight episodes Thursday, March 5. The fantasy-mystery centers on software engineer Lily (returning Garland colleague Sonoya Mizuno), who suspects her Silicon Valley company Amaya is responsible for her boyfriend's disappearance.

As she weaves her way through a high-tech maze in pursuit of the truth, she clashes with the firm's CEO (Nick Offerman, "Parks and Recreation") and security chief (Zach Grenier, "The Good Wife"). Alison Pill — currently appearing in CBS All Access' "Star Trek: Picard" as well — and stage veteran Stephen McKinley Henderson ("Fences") also are regular cast members.

Serving as writer, director and executive producer of "Devs," Garland allows that "some of the scientific and philosophical ideas that I became comfortable enough to write about — after really, like, 10 or 15 years of reading and trying to understand them — are just sort of irreducibly complicated. You can't really make them easy. You can't reduce them to sound-

bites.

"It's just about being thoughtful and not dropping too many hammer blows of big ideas ... actually drip-feeding it rather than front-loading it, I guess, but also having a kind of underlying faith that the audience will be more interested in this than we are led to believe. I think the world I came from is incredibly oppositional to complicated ideas. And the world I came into, by which I mean cinema and television, is much more open to much more free-thinking. And also, you have time. You're not trying to cram stuff into two hours."

As for the "Devs" actors responding to Garland's approach, Offerman notes, "You're used to shooting things out of sequence, and you do your best to map out the roller coaster of emotion and the dynamic that your arc requires. But this particular sort of mind-blowing, trippy material made us very grateful, I think, that by the time we were on the sound stage shooting the final couple chapters of the show, it was good that those were in order and that they were the end."

"It's a testament to Alex's writing," adds Offerman. "You know, we've all worked on a lot of different stuff. Even so, at the end of five or six months together, we were standing around in the final days still saying, 'This scene is amazing. How did he do this?'"

Q: Was Jennifer Lopez's pole-dancing routine in the Super Bowl halftime show meant to be a comment on her being denied an Oscar nomination for "Hustlers"? — Cathy Baker, via e-mail


A: It's entirely possible, and her fans speculated that was the reason it was included, though she'd have to be the one to confirm whether or not that was the intent. At the very least, it was a clever way for her to get extra mileage from the training she went through for the film, which was expected widely to nab her a bid for an Academy Award — and not only for the dancing, but for the quality of her dramatic work in the picture. She ultimately was denied that chance, though many opined that her acting career took a big step forward with that performance.

Q: Is "The Blacklist" over for this season? — Ted Simms, Reading, Pa.

A: Not yet. The NBC mystery-drama will be back with the rest of its seventh year starting March 20, and expectedly, there are lots of loose ends to be tied up — not the least of which involves Liz's (Megan Boone) mother Katarina (Laila Robins), thought by Red (James Spader) to be dead. Joely Richardson is set to appear as another woman from Red's past.

Q: How many Emmy Awards has Edie Falco won? — Peter Wagner, Norman, Okla.

A: Now back on weekly television as Los Angeles' first female police chief in the CBS series "Tommy," the actress has a total of four of those honors to date — and it's likely not a surprise that most of them were awarded for her portrayal of mob wife Carmela on the show that cemented her as a star, "The Sopranos." The fourth was for her subsequent series that also had quite a healthy run, "Nurse Jackie." Overall, Falco has received 14 Emmy nominations, also yielded by her turns on "30 Rock" and "Law & Order: True Crime."

Q: I enjoy watching ABC's overnight "World News Now," but it seems that co-anchor Janai Norman is off from it a lot. Why? — Steve Segal, via e-mail

A: She also does work for "Good Morning America," so sometimes, it's to accommodate that. Additionally, she had a vacation at the start of the year, and she and fellow "World News Now" anchor Kenneth Moton had a good time joking around about her being gone for that. Plus, Norman and her husband are expecting their second child, and some of her recent absences may be related to that situation.

Q: Is "The World's Best," the talent show that James Corden hosted, coming back? — Ellen Mason, Stuart, Fla.

A: CBS hasn't canceled the show as of this writing, but at the same time, any plans the network may have for a second season remain unclear. The program got a splashy premiere right after the Super Bowl last year and tons of promotion, and though it got a huge audience sampling on the night of the football championship, its ratings predictably took a huge dip once it moved into a regular weekly time slot. Corden also is (was?) an executive producer of the show, and he certainly has a lot on his plate these days, but he'd likely find a way to make Season 2 work if CBS wanted it.

COMMUTING BY WATER

On February 19, the Bayonne City Council approved a lease with the Port Authority for a portion of the former Military Ocean Terminal that will serve as a ferry terminal. The agreement calls for a ten-year lease of Port Authority property with a ten-year extension option. The ferry terminal will be located about half-way out on the southern side of the former base.

The new lease will enable us to begin ferry service between Bayonne and Manhattan within the next several months. Seastreak is the ferry company that has been designated to operate the service. We are very excited about the return of ferry service to Bayonne. The ferry will provide a convenient commute between Bayonne and New York City, and will make Bayonne a more attractive location for commuters. The return of ferry service is yet another sign that Bayonne is making great progress. On February 13, the day when the Port Authority approved the ferry lease, Port Authority Chairman Kevin O'Toole said, "Today's action will allow us to take an underutilized piece of port property and partner with the City of Bayonne to support much-needed trans-Hudson service connecting people to their jobs, families, and homes."

We had ferries in the not-too-distant past. Bayonne had on-again off-again ferry service between Brady's Dock (1st Street and Lex-

ington Avenue) and Manhattan (Pier 11) at various times in the 1990's. Then it ended. There were some serious attempts to bring back ferry service to Bayonne in the early 2000's. However, ultimately, they were not successful. The current waterfront development at the former Military Ocean Terminal offers ferry service an opportunity to find a new market for passengers.

As development continues at the former Military Ocean Terminal, thousands of housing units will be constructed there. We expect many of the residents will be able to walk to the ferry from their apartments. The ferry terminal will include a parking lot for those who will drive to get the boat.

In the coming months, more details will be finalized. The ferry terminal needs to be set up. A parking lot must be built. Seastreak has to develop a schedule.

Bayonne has a great location in the heart of the metropolitan area. We look forward to the day of that first ferry trip to Manhattan. Our Administration is very proud of the role we have played to make that trip happen.

It's Nik versus the volcano in ABC's 'Volcano Live! With Nik Wallenda'

Nik Wallenda regards himself as an artist who makes himself the centerpiece of a much larger canvas. And in his latest performance, it's one that contains all the el-

ements that nature can throw at him. In "Volcano Live! With Nik Wallenda," airing Wednesday, March 4, on ABC, the 41-year-old aerialist will attempt his most daring tightrope walk yet, an 1,800-foot

trek across Nicaragua's active Masaya Volcano, part of the Pacific Ring of Fire that encompasses several craters and a lava lake.

It's a stunt that captured his imagination.

"As I approached the rim of this caldera," Wallenda recalls of his first visit to Masaya, "I could tell before I even got up to it that it was the one. (It had all the elements I was) looking for and one of them had to do with the distance from one end of the rim to the other. And the height is pretty impressive. You know, the tallest building in New York City, One World Trade Center, would fit

underneath the walk between the lava and my wire. So there's just a bunch of factors that kind of came into play as I was seeking the right one and this one was just extremely attractive for that purpose."

Crossing 1,800 feet above superheated magma, Wallenda will face unpredictable wind gusts, heat that can reach 150 degrees and volcanic sulfur gases that can make breathing nearly impossible, for which he will carry a gas mask. It sounds daunting but he explains that these conditions aren't dissimilar to what he's faced before. He's just never had them all in one crossing.

"(It's) not a constant heat," he says of Masaya. "It comes in waves ... but the concern is more the wire itself and how the heat will affect the tension of the wire. That's kind of the main concern as far as the heat-related part. And then layer upon layer, of course then we're dealing with winds — everything I've dealt with over the Grand Canyon (in 2013) ..."

"Over Niagara Falls (in 2012)," he continues. "I had issues with vision because the mist was so thick. Well, I have that with gases now and then they'll burn my eyes. And then in addition to that ... the fact that I trained blindfolded, of course, for my Chicago walk (in 2014), this is kind of combining all of them into one and making it that much more of a challenge for me."

Hollywood By Tony Rizzo

HOLLYWOOD — Meryl Streep's next films are HBO Max's "Let Them All Talk," for director Steven Soderbergh, with Candice Bergen, Dianne Wiest and Lucas Hedges, and Netflix's "The Prom," a film version of the Broadway musical. Her co-stars are Nicole Kidman, Andrew Rannells and Kerry Washington.

During the Golden Age of Hollywood, studio moguls ran megastudios and actors were under exclusive contracts to appear just in their films. But today, for a superstar to remain on top they have to produce films for themselves and others. There are eight superstars who have been successful producing films that grossed well over \$200 million each.

George Clooney says he'd rather produce than act, and his most successful production was "Argo," a Best Picture Oscar winner that grossed \$232 million. His next producing project is Netflix's "Good Morning Midnight," with Felicity Jones and Kyle Chandler. Kevin Costner produced and starred in "Dances With Wolves," a Best Picture Oscar winner that grossed \$424 million. He returned two years later with "The Bodyguard," which grossed \$411 million, and then "Water World" (\$241 million). Costner is currently producing the third season of "Yellowstone" for the Paramount Network.

Tom Cruise's "Mission: Impossible" franchise films are always high grossers. The totals for the six films so far: 1. \$458 million, 2. \$546 million, 3. \$398 million, 4. \$695 million, 5. \$683 million and 6. \$791

million. In addition, Cruise also produced "Vanilla Sky" (\$203 million), "The Others" (\$210 million), "Last Summer" (\$457 million) and "Jack Reacher" (\$218 million). "Top Gun" is due June 26, and "Mission: Impossible" 7 and 8 are due in 2021 and 2022. Leonardo DiCaprio produced and starred in "The Aviator" (\$214 million) and "The Wolf of Wall Street" (\$393 million). Clint Eastwood won a best director Oscar for "Million Dollar Baby," which grossed \$217 million, and directed "Gran Torino" (\$270 million), "American Sniper" (\$547 million) and "Sully" (\$241 million).

Mel Gibson scored big producing "Braveheart" (\$210 million) and "The Passion of the Christ" (\$622 million). He's now producing "The Passion of the Christ: Resurrection" for 2021. Brad Pitt produced "The Departed" (\$291 million), "Eat, Pray, Love" (\$206 million) and "World War Z" (\$540 million). His next

is "Blonde," with Ana de Armas and Adrien Brody. But believe it or not, Bradley Cooper crushed them all with "Silver Lining Playbook" (\$236 million), "American Hustle" (\$251 million), "American Sniper" (\$547 million), "A Star Is Born" (\$425 million) and a slam dunk with "Joker," at over \$1.2 billion, which he'll share with director Todd Phillips and co-producer Emma Tillinger Koskoff. Cooper is currently producing the World War II drama "Atlantic Wall," an untitled Hulk Hogan biopic with Chris Hemsworth, and one with himself as Leonard Bernstein in a biopic. With grosses like that, who needs to act?

Chefs vie for a career-making job on 'Vegas Chef Prizefight'

Imagine cooking for hungry Las Vegas diners ready to pay top dollar for your first-class creations, all in front of TV cameras and lights. Those are the challenges and pressure faced by contestants on Food Network's latest competition series "Vegas Chef Prizefight."

Premiering Thursday, March 5, the six-episode series tasks eight elite chefs of disparate backgrounds and culinary viewpoints with arguably the toughest job interview they'll ever face, doing dinner service at different restaurants in the Caesars Entertainment realm to prove they have the talent, leadership and determination to run a high-profile restaurant in Las Vegas, one of the world's greatest foodie cities.

The winner – as determined by host Anne Burrell, chef Scott Conant, Caesars Entertainment executive Eileen Moore and rotating guest judges – lands a job as head chef at the newly created \$10 million restaurant at the Flamingo on the famed Strip.

"This is a dream job for somebody," Burrell explains, "I mean, a brand new restaurant, you get to be a part of it from the beginning. ... I don't know but I think (this is) one of the biggest stakes that Food Network has ever put on a show like this."

"They're going to be really involved in making the menu," she continues, "and they will have some input on what the design of the restaurant looks like. I mean, they are really in it. It's a big job."

And to do a job like this means having a diverse skillset. In addition to being a talented chef and expert handler of pressure, the successful candidate needs to be good teacher, a good listener and a good cheer-

leader. They also need to know when to deliver a pat on the back or kick in the backside when needed, just as any good manager does.

To demonstrate that, they'll do live dinner service at such varied Sin City eateries as Mr. Chow, BLT Steak at Bally's, El Burro Borracho at Rio and Giada at The Cromwell. In each instance, Burrell says diners were well aware they were part of a Food Network production.

And while Burrell was reluctant to give hints on challenges or the outcome, she does allow that nerves did play a part at first but dropped away as the competition progressed.

"It was really nice to see, after we got a couple of weeks into the process, people really start to be comfortable and showing us what they can do as cooks," she says. "You know, once you get past all the nerves, once you peel all of the noise away around the whole process and people really settle in and put their heads down, it got really exciting."

best of ... BEST VOLCANO MOVIES BY JAY BOBBIN

"The Last Days of Pompeii" (1935) Remade several times, this classic about discord between a Roman father and son (Preston Foster, John Wood) builds to the eruption of Vesuvius, effective here despite the relatively primitive special effects of the day – handled by two masters of the trade, "King Kong" veterans Ernest B. Schoedsack and Merian C. Cooper.

"You Only Live Twice" (1967) A good chunk of this James Bond adventure takes place inside a dormant – well, apparently dormant – Japanese volcano that enemy Blofeld (Donald Pleasence) is using as his base to launch a rocket that captures U.S. and Russian space capsules in orbit. Veteran production designer Ken Adam did an amazing job of creating a massive set for Agent 007 (Sean Connery) and his overseas allies to infiltrate.

"The Island at the Top of the World" (1974) The Disney studio got volcanic with this adventure, one of David Hartman's last projects as an actor before he became a founding co-anchor of ABC's "Good Morning America." The story involves a lost Viking civilization, but that's just a matter of marking time until the "island" blows its top.

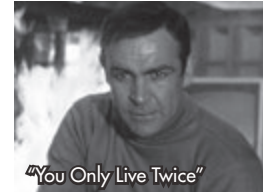
"When Time Ran Out" (1980) Some like to say the title refers to the end of producer Irwin Allen's tenure as the king of disaster movies, since this tale pretty much dismantled the genre's most successful streak ... but it still offers an effectively nightmarish view of what a reawakened volcano could mean for a nearby resort, its staff and its guests. Some of those who had worked for Allen before – including Paul Newman, William Holden, Ernest Borgnine and Red Buttons – are among those trying to duck fireballs and outrace lava here.

"Joe Versus the Volcano" (1990) The first of Tom Hanks and Meg Ryan's several screen teamings casts Hanks as a man who's informed he has a terminal illness, prompting him to spend his last days taking risks – capped by his agreement to throw himself into an active volcano.

"Volcano" (1997) Wisecracks go along with the crisis as lava flows through the streets of Los Angeles, with Tommy Lee Jones as an emergency management chief working with a geologist (Anne Heche) to contain or divert the threat before it eats its way through everything in the metropolis. A big bonus: Don Cheadle as a cucumber-cool colleague of Jones who laces his remarks with dry sarcasm back at headquarters.

"Dante's Peak" (1997) In a year that saw a battle between volcano movies, Pierce Brosnan took a breather from James Bond to play an atmospheric expert trying to warn a mayor (Linda Hamilton) to move everyone out of her district before ... well, you can guess. Particularly good in a supporting role is Charles Hallahan ("Hunter"), his last scene registering as one of the film's most memorable.

"Jurassic World: Fallen Kingdom" (2018) The most recent installment of the hugely profitable franchise makes the dinosaurs – which could be sent back into extinction – potential victims of a rapidly developing volcanic terror.
