Ann Curry helps medical patients in 'Chasing the Cure'

If a meeting between a patient and doctors on live television can have a successful result, Ann Curry wants to get it done.

The Emmy-winning news correspondent, former "Today" co-anchor and re-

cent "We'll Meet Again" host focuses on medical matters as an executive producer and the anchor of "Chasing the Cure," which TBS and TNT both premiere Thursday, Aug. 8. The 90-minute episodes tackle real-life mysteries as people whose ailments have been unsolved, undiagnosed or misdiagnosed seek help from experts in real time, with social media and a dedicated website (ChasingTheCureLive.com) also as major components.

In an interview for this article, Curry discussed the series.

Q: What is your overall approach to doing "Chasing the Cure"?

A: It's all about finding a new way of connecting people with top doctors throughout the country. Most of that will be happening online, where our website will be manned and womanned 24/7, then we will highlight cases for 10 weeks over 90 minutes — and see if we can punch a hole in what keeps people from getting all the information they need to live better, longer lives.

Q: How are you finding the medical community's general reaction to this?

A: We can't operate unless we're well-embraced by the medical community, and their initial concern was the same concern

I had as a journalist ... "What are the standards that we're going to operate under?," combining the talents of TV creators, journalists and technologists with medicine. What are the priorities? The first response was to proceed with caution, which speaks to how responsible we want our doctors to be. We did direct outreach to them, and they weren't easy to find, because they weren't looking to be on television.

The response now is that doctors, nurses and professors of medicine are saying, "Thank goodness you're doing this." I think everybody recognizes that something has to happen to allow more people into the fold. The best physicians will acknowledge that there are just too many ways that people are left behind, so what we're getting now about this is a lot of excitement.

Q: You've been soliciting the public's stories for "Chasing the Cure" via on-air ads and the show's website. What have you found the response to be?

A: It's been significant. In fact, we're a little worried, because it might exceed our expectations. Even when this was just an idea, people were submitting things. It's remarkable how many of us know someone who is struggling medically and is struggling to get a diagnosis. We've really tried to open our arms as wide as we can and do what we can for what we understand are millions of people.

'Grand Hotel' actress Adorno talks veganism and why she did it

Transitioning from an animal- to a plant-based diet doesn't happen overnight. As with anything, the body needs time to adjust and cravings occur. Also, there are social situations, restaurants, family gatherings and holidays to contend with, all tempting you to go back to old ways. A lot of people do.

But Justina Adorno, who plays socially awkward daughter Yoli in the ABC Monday drama "Grand Hotel," found an unusual but effective way of staying on her straight and narrow path toward veganism.

"It was my love for animals, honestly," she explains. "I love them so much and then I would learn another thing about what happens in the food industry and just go, 'Ugh! What am I doing?' ... Like I watch sometimes those horrible videos of ... what goes on in those factories and I feel like that's the biggest motivation for me, is just seeing the raw, nasty truth of things to make me go, 'This is reality.' So then it makes my 'poor' transition into veganism like I'm not giving anything up, actually. I'm actually saving lives instead of giving up a life, sacrificing a life."

Talk to the 28-year-old Bronx, N.Y. native and it's clear she's made the transition successfully. She's downright evangelical when extolling the virtues of a plant-based diet, saying she feels better physically and mentally, especially knowing that her diet doesn't require that animals die.

As for the food itself, she says she doesn't feel deprived, citing vegan versions of burgers, pizza, ice cream, doughnuts and cookies that she says are readily available and satisfying.

"There are cheeses," she says, "like my favorite cheese is a cashew-based cheese. It's so delicious and it's a smoked gouda and sun-dried tomato, like I'm not missing out on anything. You just have to make an extra effort to learn where you can get those things. It's all out there."

And she's a big fan of one plant-based meat.

"The Beyond Meat sausages are like ridiculously amazing," she says. "They're so good. I have never been a sausage person. And that's another thing with vegan, a lot of the foods that I wasn't crazy about, when I became vegan I was like, 'Oh my God, this is amazing!' Like sausages, doughnuts, breakfast foods - I never was into it but now I can't stop thinking about it."

As for advice she'd give to anyone considering a plant-based diet, she says, "If they're really nervous about it, to start slowly, to start basing your meals off of fruits and vegetables and grains and don't even consider (cutting out meat) yet. Make those small adjustments without putting the pressure on there ..."

Remind yourself it's something you want to do and to try to find as many good vegan spots as possible ...

Go to those restaurants that can get you inspired so that you can see how it should be done or how you like it, then you can try to bring it to the house.

"And continue to educate yourself," she continues, "on what's actually happening, depending on why you want to go vegan. If it's health reasons, educate yourself on all the health reasons why it's best to go vegan. And if it's the animals, keep watching what's happening behind closed doors because it'll keep you focused and remind you why you're doing what you're doing."

"It's an everyday practice like with anything in life."

HOLLYWOOD — Now that Disney has remade "Aladdin," "The Lion King" and sequels of "Toy Story 4" and "Frozen 2," it has turned to "Cruella," a live-action sequel to "101 Dalmatians," and a sequel to "The Little Mermaid." Originally Lindsey Lohan was cast as Ariel, but was replaced by Halle Bailey, and "This Is Us" star Chrissy Metz was replaced by Melissa McCarthy as Ursula. The role of her father, Triton, was to be played by Jeff Bridges and Prince Eric by Zac Efron, but they are not in the current plan. While "The Star Wars" sequels have been big winners for Disney, others have not. Take "Mary Poppins" (1965), which cost only \$6 million to make and earned \$103

million, five Oscar wins (including Julie Andrews) and a best-picture nomination, while "Mary Poppins Returns" cost \$30 million and grossed \$345 million. It didn't win any Oscars and didn't get a best-picture nomination. One of reasons may have been no hit songs. The original had at least four hits: "A Spoonful of Sugar," "Chim Chim Cher-ee," "Jolly Holiday" and "Supercalifragilistic-expialidocious." No hummable tunes, no repeat business.

"Ghostbusters 3" is set for July 2020, and will reunite most of the original cast — Bill

Murray, Sigourney Weaver, Dan Aykroyd, Ernie Hudson and Annie Potts — and add Paul Rudd, with Jason Reitman, the son of original director Ivan Reitman, at the helm. Dan Aykroyd promises, "This flick will connect to the first movie better than any other sequel and in a way that hasn't been done before." The 2016 film with an all-female cast earned \$229 million against a \$144 million cost. Is "Man of Steel" Henry Cavill turning in his cape for a pipe when he becomes Sherlock Holmes in "Enola Holmes"? He'll play Sherlock to Millie Bobby Brown's Enola Holmes (his much younger sister), which is based on a book by Nancy Springer. Is this the end of Superman as we know him? We know Downey Jr. had superpowers, but can he and Foxx dribble competitively against NBA stars LeBron James and Steph Curry?

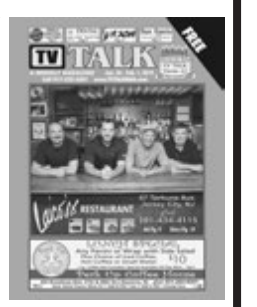
